Position Description

Mission of Worship Arts Associate – To lead, enhance, and empower leaders within the student worship experience for Middle School Students (APEX 678) and High School Students (APEX HS).

Position Purpose – Bringing young people closer in their relationship with Christ through music, worship team development, building relationships, and one-on-one coaching with student leaders. Opportunity to develop your leadership with the support of Summit staff. High potential for growth in this position.

Responsibilities – The Worship Arts Associate will be responsible for:

- Leading Student Worship
- Chart and select worship music
- Identifying, recruiting, and raising up leaders, musicians and singers from students
- Build relationships and encourage spiritual growth with band members
- Hold band rehearsal once a week (Currently on Saturdays)
- Rehearse and perform sound check on Sunday mornings (or arrange with other leaders)
- Manage schedules, recruit and develop student led tech team
- Schedule another worship leader and team when you are unavailable
- Administrate schedule for band members
- Empower and raise up gifted students to lead songs, the band and/or worship transitions
- Set up one-on-one coaching and development with students
- Monthly Sync Meeting with Student Ministries Director and Worship Arts Director for themes
- Periodically facilitate discussions for a Middle School or High School breakout
- Long range planning with Director of Student Ministries for Upcoming worship series'
- Pro Presenter programming (presentation software) with Director of Student Ministries

Minimum Qualifications –

- Proficient in vocals and one lead instrument
- Organized and responsible with strong relational and interpersonal skills
- Passionate about empowering other adults and students to lead
- Gifts of administration, hospitality and leadership

Typical hours – 15-20 hours/week (Part-time position)

- 4 Sundays per year off (required to provide own coverage through student leaders).
- Once a month sync meeting with Student Ministries Director and Worship Arts Director
- Providing monthly report of accomplishments, areas of concern, prayer requests to Worship Arts Director
- Help worship lead at special events, attend leadership nights and special meetings

Training/Support –

- Coaching with Worship Arts Director
- Meetings with Director of Student Ministries and Worship Arts Director
- Opportunity for conferences & continuing education.
- Leadership events (typically January & August)
